Assembly and dismantling from a single source

We take on the complete assembly cycle of your stand — or exactly the trades you are missing. Both are possible and both are clearly scoped.

Stand assembly

Build-up of your stand exactly to project documentation — meeting all technical requirements and hall regulations.

- Assembly to your build drawings and construction plans
- Custom and modular stands, single and double storey
- Night and weekend shifts during build-up

Dismantling

After the fair closes we take the stand down quickly and cleanly — within the organiser's time slot.

- Removal immediately after the fair closes
- Careful handling of reusable components
- Broom-clean hand-over of the floor space

System stand assembly

Modular stand systems for recurring appearances — quick to erect and reusable.

- Modular systems on standard grids
- Short build-up and dismantling times
- Repeatable assembly quality at every date

Electrics and technology

Power, lighting and AV — installed, mounted and operational before the hall opens.

- Electrical installation to the organiser's requirements
- Lighting installation
- Mounts for displays and AV equipment

What we work with

Steel structures

Two-storey frameworks, assembled with crane and access platforms.

Timber framing

Frame structures, fascias, wall cladding and fitted furniture.

Modular systems

System stands on standard grids — quick to erect, reusable.

Truss rigs

Rigs for lighting, screens and suspended elements.

LED and AV technology

Displays, light lines and mounts — installed and connected.

Electrical installation

Cabling and connections to the organiser's requirements.

Brief

The rented floor space had to yield considerably more usable area without shrinking the open exhibition level — and the stand had to be visible right across the hall.

Delivery

We erected a two-storey steel structure: column grid, beams lifted into place, and a walkable upper deck above. Beams were placed by mobile crane and assembled from powered access platforms. Cladding, glazing, a large display, timber flooring and the circular illuminated ring followed.

Outcome

Usable area doubled: open exhibition space and bar below, meeting and catering level above. The illuminated ring makes the stand recognisable from any direction in the hall.

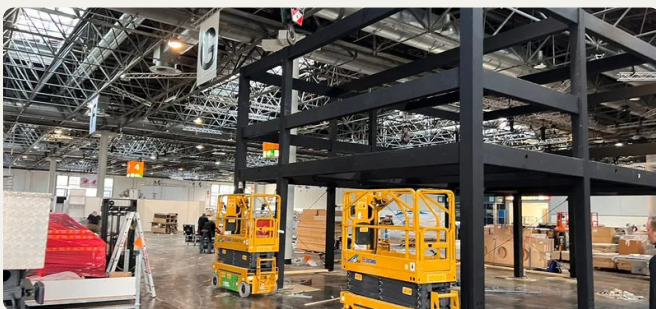

Brief

A large two-storey presence with a warm material feel — to be built inside the hall's regular build-up window.

Delivery

Structural timber was pre-sorted onto the stand floor and erected into frames there. The truss rig for lighting and suspended elements went in above, followed by fascias, wall cladding and fitted furniture.

Outcome

A complete two-storey stand, finished the evening before the fair opened — including lighting, fascia lettering and interior fit-out.

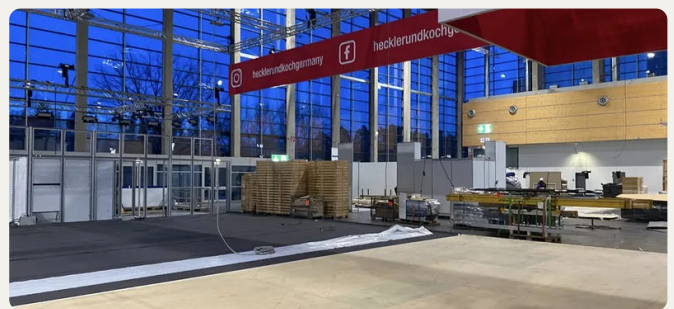

Brief

A brand presence had to run outdoors at changing locations — identical every time, built and dismantled within a few days.

Delivery

The basis is a transportable module. On site we assemble the deck, canopy, display towers, colour walls, lighting and a separate booth — to the same quality at every deployment.

Outcome

A full outdoor presence with deck, enclosed interior and technology — transportable and reproducible at any location.

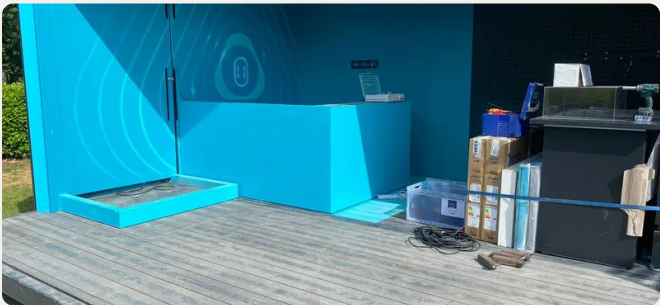

How a trade fair project runs with us

Exhibition stands rarely fail on construction and almost always on coordination. That is why our process is fixed in writing.

01 Enquiry and key data

You give us the fair, date, stand size and hall plan. We check the organiser's requirements and reply within one working day.

02 Review of project documentation

We go through your build drawings and construction plans and clarify questions before the job — not in the hall.

03 Quotation and scheduling

The quotation is broken down by trade — you can see what you are paying for. Crew, tooling and time slots are firmly booked.

04 Assembly in the hall

Build-up exactly to your project documentation, electrics, final cleaning. Hand-over of the finished stand before the hall opens.

05 Dismantling

Removal after the fair closes — fast, clean and within the organiser's time slot. The space is handed back broom-clean.

What we need from you

- Fair, hall and stand number
- Stand size in m² and type (row, corner, head, island)
- Build-up and dismantling times per the organiser
- Project documentation and build drawings of the stand
- Technical requirements: power, displays, lighting
- Budget range

The assembly crew on site

Assembly and dismantling are our core business — including stands planned by others. What clients and stand builders can expect from our crew:

Own tooling

The crew travels with a complete kit for assembly, electrics and finishing — nothing has to be rented on site.

Working to hall rules

Delivery within the assigned slot, build-up according to the organiser's guidelines, broom-clean hand-over of the space.

Assembly to your project documentation

We erect stands designed by others — exactly to your drawings, with questions clarified before the job, not surprises in the hall.

On schedule

Hand-over of the finished stand before the hall opens. During build-up phases we are reachable outside office hours too.

Crew and equipment

Fully equipped

A full kit for assembly, electrics and finishing — nothing has to be rented on site.

Experienced crews

Well-practised teams with years of experience in exhibition halls.

Electrics in-house

Electrical installation and function checks by our own assembly team.

Flexible shifts

Night and weekend work during build-up and dismantling — the deadline sets the pace.

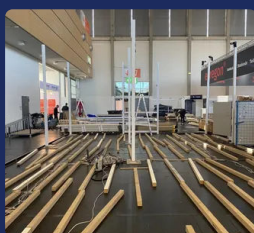
